CODE OF CONDUCT

- 10. The use or possession of weapons of any kind including any object that may be used as a weapon, including guns

- 13. Unapproved solicitation
- 14. Animals/pets (except documented service animals)
- 15. Intoxication or overconsumption of alcohol
- 16. Bringing in outside food and beverage
- 17. Failure to comply with any posted instruction or any security check or safety requirement
- 18. Minors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult

In addition to the specific examples above, please be aware that AREA15 reserves the right to take action against any other conduct on our premises that we determine to be illegal, inappropriate, offensive, dangerous, or just plain rude.
