CODE OF CONDUCT

Our team members are not shy about enforcing these guidelines. What does that mean? Violators may be refused entry, they may be asked to leave the property, and when the situation is called for, they may even be handed over to the authorities for arrest and prosecution to the extent permitted by law.

But nobody wants that, so here's what you should avoid (Honestly, it's mostly common sense – you've got this):

- Violations or attempted violations of the law
- Any activity that threatens the safety of anyone
- Any activity that threatens the well-being of the property
- Any activity that disrupts the pleasant environment
- Any activity that would disrupt the legitimate business of the property and its tenants
- Use of profanity or vulgar, racist, discriminatory, threatening or offensive language of any kind
- Unnecessarily blocking walkways, fire exits, roadways or storefronts
- Running, horseplay or disorderly conduct of any nature
- Loitering
- Smoking including vaping except in designated locations
- Possession, use, or impairment by, of any person of drugs or other illegal contraband
- Unapproved solicitation
- Animals/pets (except documented service animals)
- Intoxication or overconsumption of alcohol
- Bringing in outside food and beverage
- Failure to comply with any posted instruction or any security check or safety requirement
- Minors under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult
- The use or possession of weapons of any kind including any object that may be used as a weapon, including guns
