RESPONSIBILITIES AND DUTIES:

- Manage multiple projects simultaneously by prioritizing with department leadership the breakdown of complex tasks into manageable sub-projects.
- Coordinate project schedules, establishing critical path tasks to guarantee schedule compliance and ensuring the proper man loading requirements of contractors are communicated through meeting updates as needed.
- Communicate clearly and concisely the internal plans/methodology for due requests as needed.(Emails, Slacks, Workday, etc.)
- Oversee issuance of field directives, collection of change order requests, conversion to change orders and management approval to support accurate project deadlines and closeout.
- Work closely with various department leadership to accomplish goals by evaluating recommending, and implementing opportunities to improve internal tools and processes.
- Manage project budgets and provide project spending updates to respective Stakeholders.
- Administer and analyze creative briefs including scope of work, unit costing items, bid alternates and operational constraints required for contract preparation.
- Ensure technical feasibility of the project, resource availability and allocation.

- Maintain campaign matrixes, art files and other project layouts by cataloging and archiving them to respective databases.
- Produce timely and accurate project reports, presentation decks, and debriefs for internal reference.
- Drive efficiency by forecasting, monitoring utilization, and identifying opportunities to move projects to lower cost resources.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
